**Who Should Attend:** Managers, Cooks, Chefs, Wait staff, Supervisors, Owners, All Food Handlers.

**Why You Should Attend:** According to the National Restaurant Association, an outbreak of foodborne illness can cost your operation over \$75,000 in legal fees, medical claims, lost wages and sanitizing costs. These costs can be avoided by enrolling your staff in the ServSafe certification program.

The ServSafe program is approved for the Alabama Department of Public Health FDA Food Code adoption.

Registration must be made at least three (3) weeks prior to the scheduled date.
