Rules:

1. The canned entry must be homemade. All jars must be sealed with self-sealing lids and include rings (no rust), be filled up the first rim under lid (no wax), and have a **processing date within 12 months of the competition**.
Entrant's name should not be written on the label, but should accompany the entry.
2. Contest will be judged by an independent panel of judges not associated with the Festival.
Entries will be judged on appearance, flavor and texture.
3. All entries must be registered and brought to the Sucarnochee Folklife Festival at 9:30 a.m. on Saturday, April 21.
The contest will take place at the at Bored Well on the Sumter County Courthouse Square at 10 a.m.
The winners will be announced at 11 a.m. at the on the Festival Stage.
(Winners must be present at festival).
4. There will be a \$5 fee for each entry. All entries must be accompanied by a name, address, and phone number.
5. By participating, winners consent to the use of their name, photograph in publicity surrounding the Festival.
